NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Caddo Parish Commission, meeting in legal and regular session this 9th day of March, 2017 that it does hereby proclaim March 2017 as:

'NATIONAL WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH'

in Caddo Parish, Louisiana, and urges all citizens to join with the Parish to celebrate the recognition of this 30th Anniversary.
